# Principal's Letter to Parents Thanksgiving for Term 2, 2019

Dear Parents/Guardians,

It is with a heart of praise and thanksgiving that I write this letter at the half-year mark of our school's journey through this academic year. ### 1. Rollout of Parents Gateway

PLMGS(Sec) will be transiting to the Parents Gateway app to replace our current hard copy and email communications with parents. We will be doing so through two phases:

- (Phase 1) From Term 2 Week 9, 2019 Announcements for school, cohort and CCA activities will be sent to you via Parents Gateway.
- (Phase 2) From Term 3, 2019 <u>ALL</u> Announcements and Consent Forms for school, cohort and CCA activities will be sent to you via Parents Gateway.

Hard copy letters or Consent Forms will not to be issued from Term 3, 2019. All parents are strongly encouraged to download the Parents Gateway app into your mobile devices to continue to communicate with the teachers.

## 2. Start of the DSA-JC, EAE-Poly (4E/5N students), EAE-ITE (4NT students)

Sec 4 and 5 PL-Lites interested in applying for Direct School Admission (DSA) to Junior Colleges (JCs) for admission in 2020 may do so from May 2019. Separately, applications for early admission to the Institute of Technical Education (ITE) and polytechnics based on course-specific aptitude and interests will start in May and June 2019 respectively. O-Level PL-Lites can participate in the DSA-JC Exercise and EAE-Poly concurrently. However, they may accept <u>only one</u> offer i.e. either a DSA-JC or EAE-Poly offer.

#### 3. Travel Declaration & Monitoring of Health after June holidays

If you are travelling during the June holidays, please remind your daughters to submit an indication of the country of travel on the PLMGS(Sec) School Portal ('Ask n Learn') for our records. Do remind her to continue to monitor her health and seek medical advice, if she is unwell upon returning to school after the June holidays. For subsequent travel declarations, parents will be directed to use the Travel Declaration feature in Parents Gateway (PG) to indicate travel destinations before the year-end school holidays.

#### 4. Preparation for Teacher-Meet-Parents (TMP) 2019

Our school's TMP will be held on **30 May 2019 (Thursday), 8.00 a.m. – 4.30 p.m.** (Lunch Break for teachers: 12 noon – 12.45 p.m.). Sec 3, 4 & 5 TMP sessions will be held at the Shaw Hall; and Sec 1 & 2 TMP sessions will be held at the Parade Square. The PLMGS(Sec) Post-Secondary Education Institutions (PSEI) Fair will be held in our Canteen from 9 a.m. – 12 noon. Representatives from Polytechnics, Junior Colleges, Laselle, NAFA, and ITE, will be available to explain the post-secondary courses to all.

TMP sessions provide a platform for teachers and parents to communicate on our PL-Lites' growth and to further deepen our home-school partnership. It is also a platform for all parents to glean knowledge so that you can help give advice to the girls on their growth and discuss how to meet their aspirations. Parents are strongly encouraged to bring your daughter to meet up with the teachers during the TMP and to visit the PSEI fair together.

Please be reminded to park your vehicles at the nearby HDB carparks, as the school parade square will be used for the TMP.
