The level of attainment will be converted to bonus point(s) which can be used for admission to Junior Colleges/ Polytechnics/ Institutes of Technical Education (JC/Poly/ITE). # (b) Sec 3 Work Experience Programme (WEP)

As part of our school's Education and Career Guidance (ECG) programme, we would like to invite you to participate in our Work Experience Programme (WEP) for our Sec 3 girls. WEP requires your daughter/ward and one or two of her friend(s) to shadow you at your work place for a period of 1 to 3 days during the November/December school holidays this year-end.

Through WEP, we hope to achieve the following objectives:

- To instill positive work attitudes and values as PL-Lites observe adults working in a professional setting.
- To help PL-Lites discover their own areas of interests and passion so that the girls will be able to establish a tentative educational plan and take actionable steps towards achieving their goals.

We encourage parents to help our girls grow and learn in different dimensions. In cases where parents are unable to have their daughter shadow them, they can ask for help from friends or relatives to provide opportunities for the girls.

Appeal for Partners - The school partners a few organisations to expose our girls to an area of work that they may be interested in. We are currently looking for more parents who can be our partners in providing Work Experience attachment for our girls. # 4. Results of JC Direct School Admissions Exercises and Polytechnic/ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)

The following groups of graduating students have taken time and effort to apply for DSA or EAE in Jul/Aug 2019 and have received their results:

- Sec 4/5 O-Level students who applied for JC DSA
  A small group of girls were successful in their DSA applications to the JCs through their CCA talent areas.
- Sec 4/5 O-Level students who applied for Poly EAE
   62.5% of our Sec 4/5 O-Level girls who applied for Poly EAE, have received conditional offers for admission to their courses of choice prior to receiving their

results at the National Exams. Girls who are admitted through Poly EAE will have to meet the prevailing polytechnic admission criteria to confirm their conditional offers, which are:

- A net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or better for the GCE O-Level examinations;
   and
- o Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) for the offered polytechnic course.

#### Sec 4 NT students who applied for ITE EAE

65% of our Sec 4 NT girls who applied for ITE EAE, have received conditional offers for admission to their course of choice prior to receiving their results at the National Exams. Students admitted through ITE EAE will have to meet the prevailing Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) for the offered ITE course.
