# Principal's Letter to Parents Term 3, 2020

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The COVID-19 pandemic has brought about changes to our everyday lives at home, at work and in school. We continue to adapt and seek to be resilient in the face of new safe management measures that have to be implemented in this Phase 1:Safe Reopening. In PL(Sec), we will be doing our best to keep the PL-Lites and Staff safe this term.

### 1. Safe Management Measures

I have sent several notifications to all parents leading to the start of Term 3 to inform you of the Safe Management Measures that will be implemented in PL(Sec) during this Phase 1 of school reopening. If you have not read the notifications, do retrieve them from the PG app in your mobile devices.

We want to thank all parents for your prayers and notes of encouragement sent personally to me/the staff or through our Facebook page. Each letter was shared with the staff via email and greatly appreciated by all. They came to encourage all of us to go the extra mile for your daughters. As a school, we look forward to some kind of settling back into a new 'normal' in our school routines, so that the girls will have some happy, positive memories of the 2020 school year. This is especially important for our 2020 graduating cohort.

### 2. Phase 1: Safe Reopening

Currently, the PL-Lites are adapting to a new Semester 2 Time-table and being rotated weekly between Home-Based Learning (HBL) and returning to school for lessons.

From Term 3 Week 5, we will work towards bringing all students back to school daily, if the situation permits. MOE will monitor the situation closely and we will inform all parents in due course.

## 3. The Need to Continue to remain Cautious and Vigilant

As a school, we continue to tell the girls that even though the circuit-breaker period is over, we need to continue to remain cautious and vigilant. We have put in painstaking processes and monitoring measures in school, but we are unable to continue to monitor the girls outside school. Please work with us, to ensure that your daughters come directly to school before assembly and go straight home after school. If the girls are on HBL, they are not allowed to go out of their houses and hang around the malls or neighbourhoods after the day's work has ended. They have to continue to avoid crowds and social gatherings.

We are collecting empty pump bottles to keep our wipe-down soap solution, do let your daughters bring them to school if you have any that you want to recycle.

Social responsibility is a critical factor in stamping out the virus in Singapore. Let us all play our part in our fight against COVID-19.

### 6. Assessment updates

## (a) School-based Assessments

Term 3 Common Tests (CTs) for Sec 1-3 students will be held from 7-13 July 2020. The topics that will be tested come mainly from what the students have learnt in Term 2. The test topics will be published on our school website by 19 June 2020 (Friday).

## (b) National Assessments - 18 June 2020 GCE O-Level Mother-Tongue Examinations

The Sec 4/5 girls have just sat for their MTL Prep Exam on 4 June 2020. We enter into a season of intensive Mother Tongue revision in preparation for the 18 June 2020 national written examinations.

On 18 June 2020 (Thurs), Sec 4 Exp, 4NA and Sec 5 girls taking exam

- will **not** need to be in school in the morning;
- will need to have their lunch at home;
- will be going through just-in-time revision with their MT teachers via HBL in the morning;
- will need to report for the examinations at <u>12.50 p.m. in the school hall</u> (paying attention to the safe-distancing measures that have been put in place); and
- will need to wear in full School Uniform, bring their thermometers, EZ-link cards and the Entry proofs.

Please note that Sec 1, Sec 2 and Sec 4.9 will continue with their usual scheduled lessons <u>in school</u> on 18 June 2020 (Thursday). They will be dismissed at 12.15 p.m. The girls will need to go home for lunch on this day. Sec 4.6, 4.7, 4.8 girls who do not have GCE O-Level Mother-Tongue Examinations on 18 June 2020 will stay at home for HBL on that day.
