Principal's Letter to Parents

Thanksgiving for Term 3, 2022

Dear Parents/Guardians

The recent further easing of SMMs is a significant milestone towards living with COVID-19. Thanks to everyone's efforts, we have emerged safer and stronger together. While many SMMs are no longer mandated, we appeal for everyone, staff, students and parents, to continue to exercise personal and social responsibility. As we continue our journey towards achieving COVID-19 resiliency, we must also remain vigilant as the situation can quickly change with the emergence of new variants.

Today we also celebrated Teachers' Day. Without the teachers, coaches, instructors, school admin team, our cleaners and canteen vendors, etc., the school would not have been able to adapt and rise up to the many challenges to date, to keep everyone safe and PL open for schooling and learning.

Once again, I would like to say a BIG THANK YOU to all stakeholders – parents, teachers, staff and students – of this wonderful PL family. Let us continue to run this great race together in unity. To God be the Glory!

Let us look forward to take a break this coming September school holidays, as well as catch up on learning and work that has to be done. In this letter, please find some key information as we mark the end of Term 3 and prepare to move into Term 4.

1. Thanksgiving: 2022 Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Results (June Sitting)

Praise the Lord for the positive GCE O-Level 2022 Mother Tongue Results (2022 June Sitting), released on 18 August 2022. The positive improvement from previous years is also testament of PL-Lites' and teachers' efforts.

2. Teaching and Learning Matters

a. <u>Updated Arrangements for 2022 National Year-End Examinations</u>. We have briefed our PL-Lites taking the GCE N-Level Examinations, and will be sharing with those taking the GCE O-Level Examinations shortly. Candidates are required to adhere to the prevailing SMMs implemented by MOE (e.g. visual screening of candidates) before entering the exam venue. The key update is there is no requirement for candidates to wear face masks when they are at exam centres. Candidates who wish to wear face masks inside exam venues may continue to do so.

During the September school holidays, some Sec 4N PL-Lites will also return to school for consultations with their teachers on 5 and/or 6 September. This is to prepare our

girls for their first N-Level examinations at the start of Term 4. The school canteen will be closed and our Sec 4N PL-Lites can purchase food from our vending machines or bring light snacks if they wish.

To support our graduating cohort, we will re-introduce *Night Study in Term 4*. Some of our graduating PL-Lites have requested for a more conducive study environment in school. Night Study will be from 15 to 27 September, from 6pm to 8pm daily, unless less than 10 girls sign up for that day. More details will be shared in my next letter at the start of Term 4.

b. <u>Learning is key</u>. Our PL-Lites (except those from 4.1 to 4.5 and 5.1 who just completed their prelim exams) just received their Results Slips. How do we respond to these outcomes? I trust our parents/guardians are not focusing on the marks and grades alone, but on the overall learning and learning experiences of our PL-Lites. During this September break, our PL-Lites are encouraged to *rest*, *reflect* and *reconcile*. They are encouraged to be mindful of what they have learnt and what they are unsure of. Thereafter, our girls must take action to "make things right" and be confident of their learning and level of competence.

The Sec 1 to 3 End-of-Year (EOY) Examination Schedule is already available on our school website. Our PL-Lites have also received the topics to be assessed at the examinations via email. We urge parents/guardians to continue to support and encourage our girls. For a start, let us reassure them that we see their efforts and their individual strengths, and that excellence is a journey and not a mark or grade.

3. PLMGS 106th Founder's Day

Our 106th Founder's Day Thanksgiving Service will take place on Friday, 14 October 2022. Sec 1 to 3 PL-Lites will report to school at their usual timing. The Guest-of-Honour is Bishop of the Methodist Church in Singapore Rev Dr Gordon Wong.

This will be followed our 106th Founder's Day Thanksgiving Dinner in the evening, organised by the PL Alumni. It will be a wonderful opportunity for parents and daughters to bond and connect as we share the joy of God's abundant blessings over PLMGS in the last 106 years. The details are as follow.
