Principal's Letter to Parents Term 3, 2023

Dear Parents/Guardians

Welcome back to an exciting Term 3! I pray and trust that you and your family had spent quality time refreshing relationships. I also sincerely pray and believe that our girls had reflected on their learning in Semester 1 and are prepared to enrich themselves further in this new Semester.

To kick-start Semester 2 and celebrate our young, PL Heartbeat, an annual sporting event of customised games and activities, will take place on **Friday, 30 Jun from 12pm – 2pm**. There will be **no CCA training** after the event. Students will receive snacks and a 'surprise' to commemorate Youth Day at the end of the event.

We note recent reports of possible return of the haze with hotter and drier weather in the region. We will continue to monitor the situation and engage our girls when the need arises. We will also engage our girls on the first day of school regarding dress-down school attire due to the persisting hot weather.

1. Teaching and Learning Matters

a. <u>Early dismissal due to GCE O-Level MTL Listening Comprehension Examination on Tuesday, 4 July</u>. The GCE O-Level MTL Listening Comprehension (LC) Examination 2023 will take place on Tuesday, 4 July 2023. This is the day after the Youth Day school holiday on Monday, 3 July 2023. Please be informed of the following:

- a. <u>Semester 2 Timetable</u>. All students would have received their updated timetables for Semester 2 via email. You may wish to ask your daughter/ward to share her latest timetable with you.
- b. <u>Assessment in Term 3</u>. Similar to Semester 1, student assessments will spread across five weeks this term for Sec 1 to 3 students who will also experience Alternative Assessment practices besides written tests. The Preliminary Examinations for the Sec 4/5 students will commence this term. All students will receive their Assessment Schedules via email by the end of this week.
- c. <u>Issuance of Results Slips in Week 2</u>. All students will receive their Results Slips on Friday, 7 July in Week 2. We urge parents/guardians to continue to support and encourage our girls in their learning. For a start, let us reassure them that we see their efforts and their individual strengths, and that excellence is a journey and not a mark or grade. Let us encourage them to seek help and clarify their doubts and misconceptions with their teachers.

2. Support for Parents – "Untangled: Guiding Teenage Girls Through the Seven Transitions into Adulthood" by Dr Lisa Damour (2017)

This school holiday, I read "Untangled", a New York Times Bestseller and "award-winning guide to the sometimes erratic and confusing behaviour of teenage girls..." (www.amazon.com). I was particularly encouraged by the message to "help [our] teens use their strong emotions to make more informed decisions." The strong emotions are due to a very natural restructuring that happens in a teenage brain, specifically in the lower part of the limbic system which deals with our primal and more emotional behaviour. Later on, changes will continue in the upper and outer layer, known as the frontal cortex which helps us reflect and calm down. This second change is only complete when we are adults.

First of all, we can let our girls know that their strong emotions are all normal and importantly they must take a closer look at what these emotions really mean. The strong emotions should not be an excuse for poor decisions or impulsive behaviour. This way, she will learn to PAUSE before reacting. By helping her learn how to positively use her emotions, we will be easing her transition into mature young womanhood.
