Jump-starting her career: How teen lands dream poly course even before her O-level exams

Through the Early Admissions Exercise, she is now building a strong educational foundation at Republic Polytechnic

While most people of her age are just starting to think about their future careers, this teenager is already paving the path towards her dream job of becoming a video game concept artist. When she was in Secondary 2, Siti Nur Khadijah set her sights on pursuing her passion in video games and art, and decided that she wanted apply for a diploma course at Republic Polytechnic (RP) via the Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) in her graduating year.

Her foresight and forward planning paid off when she was in Secondary 4. Through EAE, Khadijah was offered a conditional place at Republic Polytechnic's Diploma in Design for Games & Gamification course, even before she took her O-level exams in 2020.

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Recognising all-rounded students

The EAE is an admissions exercise that lets students apply and receive conditional offers for admission to polytechnic courses prior to receiving their final exam grades. Applicants are evaluated based on their aptitude and interests, thus

What is Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)?

- An <u>aptitude-based admissions exercise</u> that allows students to apply for and receive conditional offers for admission to Polytechnics OR ITE courses <u>prior</u> to receiving their O or N level results.
- It allows the polytechnics and ITE greater flexibility to select and <u>admit students</u>
 <u>based on their aptitudes and interests</u>, <u>apart from academic grades</u>, thus allowing a wider range of talents to be recognized.



How can I start preparing for Poly/ITE Early Admissions Exercise?

1. Personal Statement Write-up

[600 characters for Poly; 100 words for ITE]

→ Based on your Interests, Evidence and Aspirations

2. Portfolio Building

3. Interviews







Nanotechnology and materials science is the advanced study and research of ways to manipulate matter at the microscopic scale, as well as the application of such concepts to be used across many other fields of science - such as biology, chemistry, and physics. 'Nano', a Latin word derived from its Greek root word 'nanos' meaning 'dwarf', is defined as a unit prefix meaning "one billionth" in the metric system. As a result, 'nanotechnology' is the application of technological methods at very tiny scales. The scientific apparatus that are utilised to enhance our study of nanotechnology will be unique instruments rarely seen outside of the field. Take, for example, atom probes and the nuclear magnetic resonance (NMR) spectrometers. These tools are hardly seen in other fields, and thus nanotechnology is a very special cross between the fields of engineering, technology and science. This course assures its students with maximum exposure to the emerging skills and ever-expanding technologies of this era. This

includes the application of state-of-the-art skills such as Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, and Data Analytics into improving society's day-to-day life, such as the food we eat, the clothes we wear, the buildings and houses we live in, and our own bodies.

Bonus Qn: What is JC-DSA?

- Direct School Admission(DSA) allows students to apply to a JC
 <u>before</u> taking the GCE O-Level examinations.
- For students who are <u>strong in academic</u> and have <u>outstanding</u> <u>records</u> in either CCAs, leadership qualities, or in specific academic areas
- To keep the conditional DSA JC offer, student <u>must meet the</u> <u>minimum entry requirement</u> for JC





The bonus points will only come into effect when the applicant has been deemed eligible and is being considered for posting based on merit.

Types of Bonus Points	Number of Bonus Points Awarded
For applicants with the following CCA grades:	
a) Excellent or Grades of A1 - A2	2 points
b) Good or Grades of B3 - C6/Non-Sensitive	1 point





Other Updates – for those considering <u>A level track</u>


- From 2026, the fourth content-based subject will be included in the computation of UAS <u>only if it improves</u> <u>the UAS</u>. This will allow JC/MI students room to choose their fourth contentbased subject by interest without being overly concerned by examination grades.
- Change Project Work (PW)'s grading to "Pass/Fail" means that it will be removed from the computation of UAS. Hence, from 2026, the maximum UAS will become 70 points.
