





JAE 2019 POSTING RESULTS



Students who are offered a course in a JC/MI must report to the school on the date stipulated.

Students who are offered a course in a Poly/ITE should expect to receive an enrolment package and are required to complete online enrolment by the date stipulated to confirm your acceptance for the course of study.

Students who fail to report to the JC/MI/Poly/ITE on the stipulated dates are deemed to have forfeited her place.

JOINT POLY/ITE ONLINE APPEAL PORTAL

Students who wish to appeal for a place in a Poly and ITE after the posting results may do so online through Joint Poly/ITE Appeal Portal.



JOINT POLY/ITE ONLINE APPEAL PORTAL



Students who did not receive any posting and did not submit an appeal via the JAE appeals exercise will automatically be offered a place, e.g. in Poly or Higher Nitec or Nitec course at ITE with vacancies at the end of the online appeal.
