Information For Students on Key Dates for Jan 2023 intake

1. All N(A)*/N(T) school leavers are encouraged to put in an application during the **1st Phase (Main Phase)** between **19 Dec 2022 (2.30pm) to 22 Dec 2022 (5pm)**. Application results for the 1st Phase will be released on **30 Dec 2022 at 9am**.
2. If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered **before** applying in the **2nd Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase)** between **30 Dec 2022 to 4 Jan 2023**. The application results for the 2nd Phase will be known on **11 Jan 2023 at 9am**.
3. Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the **3rd Phase (Final Top-up Phase)** between **11 Jan to 19 Jan 2023 and 27 Jan to 8 Feb 2023** for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3rd Phase will be known between **16 Jan to 27 Jan 2023** and **27 Jan to 14 Feb 2023**.

If you have applied for the following course(s) under Aptitude-Based Admissions as your choice(s), you may be shortlisted to attend one interview on **Tue 27 Dec 2022 or Wed 28 Dec 2022**. For courses under Aptitude-Based Admissions, applicants must first meet the ITE aggregate point for the course to be shortlisted. Shortlisted applicants will be required to attend one interview to assess their suitability for the course. Shortlisted applicants who are not successful at the course interview will be considered for their remaining choices without interview requirement based on merit. Applicants applying for other courses are not required to attend interview unless otherwise indicated.

Shortlisted applicants who have provided a valid email address and/or mobile phone number during application will also be notified to check their interview details via email and/or mobile phone on Fri 23 Dec 2022 (from 2pm).

Please note that if you have applied for the following courses, you may be shortlisted for an interview on **27 Dec (Tues) or **28 Dec (Wed)**. Please do not travel during these two dates as you will not be considered for the course if you do not attend the interview.**

BONUS POINTS (PG 17)

Bonus Points

The table below provides details for the computation of bonus points available. Please note that these bonus points are not taken into account when considering whether applicants are eligible for courses. The bonus points will only come into effect when the applicant has been deemed eligible and is being considered for posting based on merit.

Types of Bonus Points	Number of Bonus Points Awarded
For applicants with the following CCA grades: a) Excellent or Grades of A1 - A2 b) Good or Grades of B3 - C6	2 points 1 point
Applicants with GCE 'N (Academic)' level grades of 1 to 5 for pre-requisite subjects (e.g. Mathematics, English and Science) for the courses applied for.	2 points for each pre-requisite subject, up to a maximum of 4 points for the course applied.

Step 3

Choose a course and check the MERs.

She is keen on both Nitec in Rapid Transit Technology & 3-year Higher Nitec in Business Information Systems. She checks the **Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs)**, which indicates that both courses require **3 GCE 'N' Passes** in **Mathematics** or **Science** and **two other subjects**.



Step 4

Include the **pre-requisite subject** (Mathematics or Science in this example), and include the next best 3 subjects

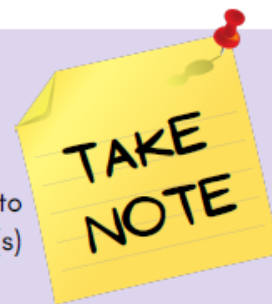

Check for applicable **bonus points** to deduct

Step 6

NOTE:

Net aggregate of best 4 subjects varies from course to course, and is dependent on the **pre-requisite** subject(s) indicated in the **minimum entry requirements (MER)**. As such, **repeat steps 3 to 5** to calculate the aggregate for **each course**.

Key Pointers for Students on ITE's Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) for Admission to Nitec Courses

ALL N(T) students and N(A) students (who are not progressing to 5N(A) or repeating 4N(A)) are eligible for JIE.

Keen competition for Nitec and Higher Nitec courses, so use all 12 choices wisely!

Participation in Main Phase is key to secure a place in ITE!

If you are keen in the work & learn option, you may consider applying for the ITE Traineeship programme. Do apply in the Main Phase to avoid missing a place in ITE!

If you are unsuccessful in EAE, make sure you apply in Main Phase to avoid missing a place!

If you have received an additional letter, then you are eligible for the 3-year Nitec Programme (eNFP).

If you are eligible for eNFP, make sure you apply for the 2-year Nitec and 3-year Higher Nitec first before applying for eNFP!




The eNFP helps to build the necessary literacy and numeracy foundations that will enable you to successfully complete your Nitec course!

If you are counter-offered a course, accept it first before appealing for another course you may be more interested in!

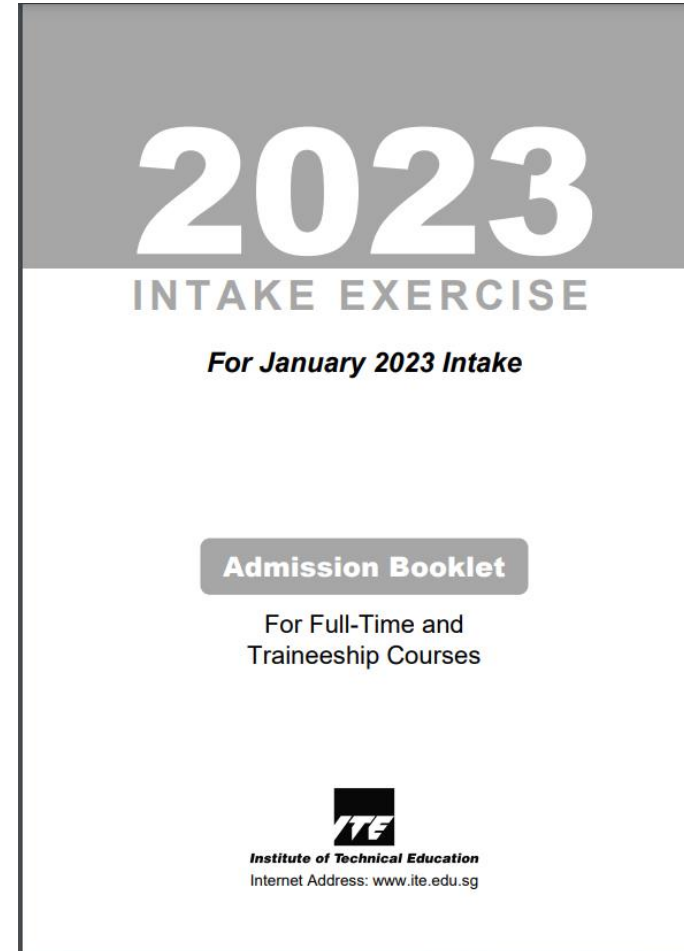
