Principal's Letter to Parents Term 1, 2018

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The new school term has passed so quickly. We are thankful that the girls have settled down into the new school year and have continued to learn and grow up through the experiences that they have gone through this term.

1. Developing Executive Functions

Most girls I speak to, feel sufficiently mature to run their own lives. However, we see them being disorganized. They may not responsible enough to understand the urgency of a task that they are given. Some lack the drive and motivation to exhibit on-task behaviours etc. Many of them, especially at lower secondary levels, need plodding by teachers or family members to get things done. As they grow up, they will continue to develop a set of mental skills that will help them carry out tasks to reach a final goal. This set of special skills is named **Executive Functions.**



3. GCE N- and O-Level Examinations for Coursework Subjects

Coursework is a major component for subjects such as Art, Design and Technology, Food and Nutrition, Food Studies and Elements of Business Studies as shown in the table below.

4. Aptitude-based admissions exercises for O- and N-Level students

The following are upcoming aptitude-based admissions exercise that allows students to apply for and receive conditional offers for admission to polytechnics/ITE prior to receiving their final national exam grades. It allows the polytechnics and ITE greater flexibility to select and admit students based on their aptitudes and interests, apart from academic grades, thus allowing a wider range of talents to be recognised.
