Her roles are:

- To provide ECG counselling for students and/or parents, especially during critical decisionmaking junctures; including alumni students who are in transition from our secondary school to prior to admission to junior colleges/ centralised institute or PSEIs
- To support students through conducting ECG workshops to help them further explore their strengths, interests, aspirations, education and career pathways, including employment preparation (e.g. writing of personal statements, resume-reviews, mock interviews etc)

3. GCE O-Level MTL & GCE N-Level EL Oral Exams

GCE O-Level MTL & GCE N-Level EL Oral Exams will be from **4 July to 16 July**. Students to be tested for **CL & EL** oral in school will be dismissed from classes at **12.50pm**. This includes sec 3 HMT students taking O-Level MT oral exam. Students travelling to other schools will leave class at **12.15 pm**.

4. Car Parking Arrangements for Parents and Visitors to PLMGS(Sec)

Please be informed of the following with effect from 1 August 2018:

- Parents and visitors driving into PLMGS(Sec) must have a valid (yellow) Car Decal displayed prominently on the windscreen of the car. The Car Decals can be requested from the school General Office.
- Parents and visitors, who are picking up the girls during dismissal times and will need
 to wait temporarily, should park their cars in available drawn carpark lots. This is to
 prevent cars from blocking the main thoroughfare and to reduce the risks of accidents
 within our carparks. We would also like to remind drivers to switch off the engines
 when the cars are parked, to prevent air pollution.
- For information, the school staff and vendors will need to start paying for season parking within our school with effect from Aug 2018.
- Parents and visitors who are attending school events (such as Prayer meetings, PSSG activities) will be directed to park at the visitors' lots by the school security guards, subject to availability of lots.
- Event-specific carpark decals will be issued to parents and visitors for each schoolorganised activity. This should be displayed prominently on the cars' dash board during the activity. There will be no carpark charges for parents and visitors in such situations.
- There will be **no provision** for parents and visitors to park their cars in our school for any other unauthorised reasons. In cases like these, parents and visitors are advised to park their cars in nearby public carparks.
