Completing this learning responsibly will provide our girls with a stronger foundation for their Sec 4 curriculum next year. Girls who do not have access to a home-based internet connection via a computer, can access the free-to-loan computers at the school library. The school Library will be open every Mondays - Fridays, 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
