- A continuous review of your progress
- Tedious but necessary

Strategy 1: Questioning

- Use questions – write out your notes by answering questions on the topic
- Write out your own open-ended questions related to the topic that will require you to think through your answers.



Strategy 2: Recall and Summarise

- stop every few minutes to recap what you've read.
- Write a short summary using your own words.
- Write your notes down from memory and then going back over them, filling in the gaps with another coloured pen.

Strategy 3: Draw and Doodle

- For a visual learner, break down information into drawings or diagrams
- mind maps and freehand drawings are useful in improving understanding and as memory aids
- Use COLOUR to highlight
